Get ready to **ROCK** for our biggest fundraiser of the year, to support Band, Color Guard, and Stars on Friday, August 19th in the CHS Commons! Students will “rock out” for the evening on behalf of the Band, Color Guard and Stars Programs. This is one of our major fall fund-raisers. The money goes toward drill and music arrangement, visual choreography, costumes, clinicians, and other educational and instructional materials. Check-in begins at 9pm and pick up starts at 5:30 a.m. Saturday. All money and permission forms must be turned in to the Booster Club parents or band hall mailbox no **later than Thursday, August 18th**.

Donations! There is a minimum \$100 entry fee to the Rock-A-Thon. But don't just ask your parents for money – earn it! Get together with your section and play your instruments in the community for donations, entertain your neighbors or extended family, perform at parties for pay ... whatever is fun. Then, ask your parents for a contribution or for matching funds. If your donors request a receipt, donation receipts are included with this packet and are available online at the website. All donations must be turned in by Aug. 18th.

Entertainment! We'll be rockin' out to the DJ during the evening. Band sections and Guard and Stars teams can get together for an “act” to entertain the audience, which may include karaoke, teaching dance moves, game show, contests, or whatever each group requests (sign up with the drum majors by Thursday, Aug. 18th). Entertainment can be as short as 2-5 minutes. There will also be an open gym, inflatables, poker tournament, and other entertainment.

Prizes! Various prizes will be awarded throughout the evening, including 4 grand prizes: student getting the most money donated, student getting the most sponsors, and groups getting the most donations and sponsors. Prizes will also be awarded during the Poker Tournament, so bring your best poker face! Parents, please contact Booster Club officers if you would like to donate prizes.

What to Bring! Bring any entertainment systems you would like to play during the evening. You may also bring a sleeping bag and pillow or blankets. If you want to bring bean bags or other easy-to-maneuver chairs, feel free. You can bring PJ's, but remember this is a

school activity, and dress code applies and will be enforced.

Timing: The Rock-A-Thon will begin at 9pm and pickup starts at 5:30am on Saturday. **All students must be picked up no later than 6:00am.** The inflatables will be starting at app. 9:30 pm, the DJ will start at 10pm and the poker tournament will begin at 2a.m. Games and other entertainment are also being organized by Band, Guard, and Stars officers to provide non-stop entertainment all night long! Students are free to play or rest as they choose. For those who want non-stop action, the gym will remain open all night.

******IMPORTANT!! -- If you need to leave early (no later than 1:30 am), you must have a signed parental note on record with Mr. Galloway or Ms. Barth no later than Thursday, Aug. 18th stating when you will leave and how you will be transported. If parents are picking you up, they must come in to show identification. If you have written permission to drive yourself, parents will be called by chaperones to confirm that you are on your way home.**

All students will be start being dismissed at 5:30 a.m. Saturday morning.

ROCK-A-THON LOCK-IN RULES:

1. A minimum \$100 pledge will be required of all students to enter party, with student ID.
2. Admittance to the party will be between 9p.m-11p.m. Doors will be locked from 11pm to 5:30 am. Only Clements Band, Guard, and Stars Students are permitted to attend.
3. Any student who must leave before 1:30 am will only be released to the Parent/Guardian who signed the consent form below, with a pre-approved permission note from that parent. **Anyone who leaves will not be allowed to return.**
4. Students are encouraged to bring sleeping bag, pillow, and any items they may want to use during the lock-in. Please leave all money and valuables at home. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
5. Absolutely no admittance will be allowed if there are any signs of alcohol or drug use. Students are not allowed to bring any types of weapon. Determination of such will be at the discretion of Security and their judgment will be final.
6. Any member of the Security staff reserves the right to eject a participant who becomes unruly or violates school policy. The Parent/Guardian giving consent will be called to pick up the student. Parent identification will be needed.
